SENATE BILL NO. 3139 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF 1 2 STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF 3 THE CONSOLIDATED OPERATION OF THE EDUCATION AND RESEARCH CENTER, THE UNIVERSITY RESEARCH CENTER AND MARIS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 8 of State Institutions of Higher Learning, who is assigned custody 9 10 and management of the center: (1) to defray the expenses of operating and maintaining the Education and Research Center of 11 12 Mississippi and the Mississippi Automated Resource Information System (MARIS), including but not limited to the maintenance of 13 said buildings and grounds and expenses for fuel, water, 14 15 electricity, telephones, supplies and salaries for personnel necessary therefor; and (2) to be used for the support and 16 17 maintenance of the University Research Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000 18 3,882,543.00. 19 \$ 20 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special funds which are collected by or otherwise become available and funds available from building use charge for the following purposes: (1) to defray the expenses of operating and maintaining the Education and Research Center of Mississippi and the Mississippi Automated Resource Information System (MARIS), including but not limited to the maintenance of said buildings and

No. 3139 99\SS26\A254SG PAGE 1 grounds, and expenses for fuel, water, electricity, telephones, supplies and salaries for personnel necessary therefor; and (2) to be used for the support and maintenance of the University Research Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 1,506,791.00.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

39 SECTION 3. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 40 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 41 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of 42 Mississippi and Section 25-4-103, Mississippi Code of 1972.

43 SECTION 4. All fees charged and collected by the University 44 Research Center for services provided by the Mississippi Automated 45 Resource Information System (MARIS) shall be deposited in a 46 special fund to be known as the "Mississippi Automated Resource 47 Information System (MARIS) Revolving Fund." All monies in the 48 revolving fund shall be used by MARIS exclusively for the support 49 of MARIS projects and activities.

50 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 51 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2001 shall be submitted to 52 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 53 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 54 during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request process.

55 SECTION 6. Of the funds authorized for expenditure in 56 Section 2, the following amounts shall be derived from the 57 Education Enhancement Fund as follows:

- 58 (a) Four Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand Four Hundred
 59 Twelve Dollars (\$429,412.00) shall be derived from
 60 funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
 61 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 62 (b) One Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00)
 63 shall be derived from funds deposited pursuant to
 64 Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code of 1972.

65 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, funds in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) are 66 67 provided for the purpose of defraying the expenses of preparing an economic assessment of the riverboat gaming industry in the State 68 69 of Mississippi. This study is to include but not be limited to an analysis of the problem, opportunities and growth potential of the 70 riverboat gaming industry in Mississippi. The study is to include 71 revenue growth projections for local and state government and to 72 73 determine whether riverboat gaming revenues will help stabilize or 74 destablize revenue collections during an unstable economy. The University Research Center may request the assistance of 75 76 university personnel and may contract with public or private 77 resources for the purposes of conducting this study.

78 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 79 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 82 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 83 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 85 and after July 1, 1999.
