That the following sum, or so much thereof as may 7 be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 8 of State Institutions of Higher Learning to be used for the 9 10 operation of the College of Veterinary Medicine at Mississippi State University, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and 11 12 ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 11,259,437.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 14 15 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the College of 16

18 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30,

20 SECTION 3. Any transfer shall be made in accordance with the
21 terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

26 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 27 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2001 shall be submitted to

31 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 32 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 33 Fund as follows:

SECTION 7. Should revenues generated and deposited to the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

88 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 89 90 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 92 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 93 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 95 and after July 1, 1999.

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
