AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 2 MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY; AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF 3 ESTABLISHING A DISASTER RELIEF RESERVE FUND AND DEFRAYING THE COSTS RELATED TO CERTAIN DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS, FOR FISCAL 4 5 YEAR 2000. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 8 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management 10 Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et 11 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 12 13 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 933,641.00. 14 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 15 16 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source 17 funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the 18 support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year 19 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 20 21 .....\$ 2,432,568.00. Funds are provided to adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand 59 60 Dollars (\$1,000.00).

61 (C) If an employee is currently at or above the end salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 62 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 63 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 64 65 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the effective date of the increase. 66 Employees who subsequently 67 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 68 69 effective the date of the rating.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

81 SECTION 4. Funds are provided in this act to establish one 82 (1) new Purchasing Agent II position and three (3) EM-83 Communications Specialist positions.

84 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon 85 86 the request of a local public emergency management organization in 87 an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to 88 rural water associations to enable their continued operation when the local emergency management organization determines that such 89 90 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the 91 community.

92 SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 93 necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 107 108 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 109 372U for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses 110 and the federal share of the cost of the Hazard Mitigation Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 111 112 June 30, 2000.....\$ 4,000,000.00. SECTION 9. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 113 114 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 115 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 116 Nos. 372M and 372P for the purpose of defraying certain 117 administrative expenses and the state and federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the February 118 119 1991 Flood, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 120 June 30, 2000.....\$ 50,000.00. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 144 145 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 146 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 147 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 148 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 149 Public Assistance Program resulting from the Lowndes County 150 Disaster, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 151 June 30, 2000.....\$ 600,000.00. 152 SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 153 154 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 155 Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain 156 administrative expenses and the state and federal share of the 157 cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the 1994 Ice Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 158 159 June 30, 2000.....\$ 3,200,000.00.

SECTION 15. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 372G for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses and the federal share of the cost of the Nuclear Preparedness Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 323,800.00.

167 SECTION 16. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 168 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 169 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 3724 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of providing 170 171 individual and family disaster relief assistance for personal 172 property losses and damages resulting from disasters declared by the federal government, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 173 174 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 1,000,000.00.

175 SECTION 17. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 176 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 177 178 Nos. 3724 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses and the state and federal share of the 179 180 cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from Hurricane 181 Georges, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 182 June 30, 2000.....\$ 10,500,000.00.

183 SECTION 18. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 184 185 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 186 187 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 188 Public Assistance Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000. 189 190 \$ 3,500,000.00. 191 SECTION 19. The funds appropriated in Section 6 shall be

192 expended only as provided in Sections 43-41-1 et seq. and

193 43-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, or for the purpose of 194 matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the 195 state.

196 SECTION 20. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be 197 paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General 198 Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon 199 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 200 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 201 202 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 203 SECTION 21. This act shall take effect and be in force from 204 and after July 1, 1999.
