AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 2 MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY; AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF 3 ESTABLISHING A DISASTER RELIEF RESERVE FUND AND DEFRAYING THE COSTS RELATED TO CERTAIN DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS, FOR FISCAL 4 5 YEAR 2000. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management 10 Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et 11 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 12 13 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 917,289.00. 14 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 15 16 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source 17 funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the 18 support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year 19 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 20 21 .....\$ 2,421,623.00. SECTION 3. It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

81 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon 82 83 the request of a local public emergency management organization in 84 an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to rural water associations to enable their continued operation when 85 86 the local emergency management organization determines that such 87 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the 88 community.

89 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 90 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall 91 provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors, 92 mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in 93 disaster management.

94 SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 95 96 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency Management Agency to be used to establish a special reserve fund 97 98 in the State Treasury for Disaster Relief, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 99 99,750.00. 100 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 101 102 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 103 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 104 Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain 105 administrative expenses and the federal share of the cost of the Disaster Relief Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 106 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 5,856,000.00. 107 108 SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 109 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 110 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 372U for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses 111 112 and the federal share of the cost of the Hazard Mitigation Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 113 114 June 30, 2000.....\$ 15,200,000.00. 115 SECTION 9. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 116 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 117 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund Nos. 372M and 372P for the purpose of defraying certain 118 119 administrative expenses and the state and federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the February 120 121 1991 Flood, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 122 June 30, 2000.....\$ 50,000.00. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 146 SECTION 13. necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 147 148 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 149 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 150 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the Lowndes County 151 152 Disaster, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 153 June 30, 2000.....\$ 600,000.00. SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 154 155 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 156 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 157 Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses and the state and federal share of the 158 159 cost of the Public Assistance Program resulting from the 1994 Ice

160 Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 3,200,000.00. 161 162 SECTION 15. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 163 164 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 372G for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses 165 of the cost of the Nuclear Preparedness Program, for the fiscal 166 year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 167 168 .....\$ 323,800.00. 169 SECTION 16. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 170 171 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 3724 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of providing 172 individual and family disaster relief assistance for personal 173 property losses and damages resulting from disasters declared by 174 175 the federal government, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 176 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 1,000,000.00. SECTION 17. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 177 178 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 179 180 Nos. 3724 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain 181 administrative expenses and federal share of the cost of the 182 Public Assistance Program and the Individual and Family Grant 183 Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 184 185 .....\$ 30,500,000.00. SECTION 18. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 186 187 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 188 189 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 190 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program and the Individual and Family Grant 191 192 Program resulting from Hurricane Georges, for the fiscal year

193 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... .....\$ 1,500,000.00. 194 195 SECTION 19. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 196 197 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses 198 199 and the federal share of the cost of the Public Assistance Program 200 resulting from the December 1998 Ice Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 201 202 \$ 8,000,000.00. 203 SECTION 20. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 204 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 205 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 206 Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 207 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 208 Public Assistance Program resulting from the December 1998 Ice 209 Storm, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 210 June 30, 2000.....\$ 500,000.00. 211 SECTION 21. The funds appropriated in Section 6 shall be 212 expended only as provided in Sections 43-41-1 et seq. and 213 43-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, or for the purpose of 214 matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the 215 state. 216 SECTION 22. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by

this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be 217 218 paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General 219 Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 220 221 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 222 223 SECTION 23. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1999. 224
