4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be б necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the general expenses of the operation of the Mississippi 8 9 National Guard for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and 10 ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 6,094,183.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Mississippi National 13 Guard, out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund--No. 3700, as created by Chapter 187, Laws 14 of 1954, as amended; the Service Contract Fund--No. 3701; the Camp 15 Shelby Base Operations Fund--No. 3705; the Air National Guard 16 Training Site Base Operations Fund--No. 3709; and the Education 17 Enhancement Fund, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions 18 of applicable statutes and federal/state agreements for the fiscal 19 20 year beginning July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2000..... .....\$ 52,654,368.00. 21 22 SECTION 3. From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
appropriated herein.

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

210 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 211 212 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 213 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 214 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 215 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 216 217 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating. 218

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

224 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

225 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. In addition to any other funds herein authorized, 230 the following sum is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 231 232 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 233 National Guard for the construction of an armory at Brookhaven, 234 Mississippi, and to authorize the use of part of such funds in matching any federal funds that may be available to the state for 235 236 armory construction, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 237 1,100,000.00.

In addition to any other funds herein appropriated, the following sum is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi National Guard for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section concerning federal/state construction agreements for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 4,643,000.00.

245 SECTION 5. In addition to all other funds herein appropriated, the following sum or so much thereof as may be 246 247 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 248 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi National Guard for the construction of an armory at Senatobia, 249 250 Mississippi, authorized in Senate Bill No. 3210, Regular Session of 1998, and to authorize the use of part of such funds in 251 252 matching any federal funds that may be available to the state for 253 armory construction, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 254 1,513,000.00. 255 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the

256 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 257 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 1999, or change the

258 purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

259 SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 260 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the 261 special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the 262 Mississippi National Guard, for the construction of an armory at 263 Senatobia, Mississippi, as authorized in Senate Bill No. 3210, 264 Regular Session of 1998, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 265 1999, and ending June 30, 2000...... \$ 4,500,000.00.

SECTION 7. All funds authorized to be expended herein shall 266 267 be expended and otherwise accounted for in accordance with the provisions of Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 268 269 If not needed for other purposes, the Adjutant General is hereby 270 expressly authorized to invest any part of or all monies herein appropriated out of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund at the highest 271 272 rate of interest obtainable and credit interest accruing on such 273 investments to the respective fund. Such monies may be invested 274 in any short-term bonds, notes or other direct obligations of the United States of America or the State of Mississippi or any county 275 276 or municipality of this state, which said county or municipal 277 bonds have been approved by a reputable bonds attorney or have 278 been validated by a decree of the court, and in any event the said 279 bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are invested shall 280 mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds so invested 281 will be needed for the refund or refunds herein provided for.

SECTION 8. The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds which may become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi National Guard is hereby authorized and approved, provided such expenditures are reported and otherwise handled in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

288 SECTION 9. The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds 289 which may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for 290 construction purposes is hereby authorized and approved, provided

291 such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise handled 292 in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 293 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two Million Eighty-six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-three Dollars (\$2,086,683.00) shall be derived from Education Enhancement Funds deposited pursuant to Section 27-103-203 (1), Mississippi Code of 1972. These funds are provided for the support of the Youth Challenge Program at Camp Shelby.

300 SECTION 11. Authority is hereby granted for the merger of 301 the following special fund accounts: Service Contract Fund, Air 302 National Guard Training Site Base Operations Fund and Camp Shelby 303 Base Operations Fund. Expenditure authority for the special fund 304 created as a result of the merger shall be limited to and not 305 exceed the combined totals of the original appropriations by major 306 object of expenditure categories and authorized positions.

307 SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 308 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 309 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 310 311 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 312 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 313 314 and after July 1, 1999, except for Section 11 which shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. 315
