27 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 28 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 29 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 30 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 31 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 32 33 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 34 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 35 36 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 37 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1999. 38
