From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

37 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous

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61 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 Provided, however, that all funds received from any and all 68 sources shall be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury 69 to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market.

70 The board shall promulgate and adopt reasonable SECTION 3. 71 rules and regulations, including employing attendants, to regulate 72 and provide for the parking of motor vehicles at the farm produce 73 marketing facility near the Mississippi Memorial Stadium for 74 regularly scheduled football games, and said board shall make said 75 facility available for such purpose and shall make a reasonable 76 charge therefor comparable to the charge made for parking in the 77 area contiguous to the stadium. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 83 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 86 87 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88 and after July 1, 1999. 89

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
