From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

46 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous

Employees who subsequently 62 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 63 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 64 effective the date of the rating.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

76 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 77 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 78 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 79 80 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 81 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 82 83 and after July 1, 1999.

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
