The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission 8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Mississippi Fair 9 10 Commission, the Mississippi Livestock Coliseum, the Industrial Showcase, the Trade Mart Building and for the purpose of paying 11 any indebtedness which may accrue for the period beginning upon 12 passage and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 13 3,335,921.00. SECTION 2. From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

39 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
40 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
41 appropriated herein.

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00).

If an employee is currently at or above the end 49 (C)50 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 51 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 52 53 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 54 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 55 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 56 effective the date of the rating. 57

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for

63 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 64 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. No operation, maintenance or service contracts, agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi Code of 1972.

76 SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated herein, not to exceed 77 Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), the Mississippi Fair Commission shall conduct a feasibility study to determine the financial and 78 79 economic impact of having a professional hockey league based in 80 the Mississippi Coliseum. The Mississippi Fair Commission shall 81 provide a report of this feasibility study to the Legislature no later than January 5, 2000. 82

83 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 84 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 85 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 86 87 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 88 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 89 90 and after its passage and through June 30, 2000.
