SENATE BILL NO. 3152 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTRY 2 3 EXPERIMENT STATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be б necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry 8 9 Experiment Station for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 10 21,741,175.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 13 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi 14 Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station for the fiscal year 15 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 16\$ 17 8,146,084.00. SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 18 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds 19 20 which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 21

22 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that if the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly 23 or indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants, 24 25 research grants or donations, such special source funds not 26 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and

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27 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the 28 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special 29 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2000 30 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature.

31 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 32 agency's budget request for fiscal year 2001 shall be submitted to 33 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 34 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 35 during the fiscal year 2000 budget request process.

36 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 37 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 38 Fund as follows:

39 (a) One Million Five Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand One
40 Hundred Ten Dollars (\$1,538,110.00) shall be derived
41 from funds deposited pursuant to Sections
42 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
43 (b) Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be

45 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 7. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 99 100 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 101 102 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 103 SECTION 11.
