L1	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L2	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
L3	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available,
L4	for the support and maintenance of the Alcorn State University
L5	Agricultural Programs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999,
L6	and ending June 30, 2000\$ 2,131,523.00.
L7	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the

29	Sections 1 and 2, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may
30	be necessary shall be expended for the purposes hereinafter set

33	Center at Alcorn State University, the sum of \$ 583,249.00
34	(b) For the support of the Cooperative Extension
35	Program services provided by Alcorn State University, the sum of.

39	the sum of\$ 365,269.00

- 77 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 79 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 80 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 81 and after July 1, 1999.
