SENATE BILL NO. 3154 (As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE 3 FOREST AND WILDLIFE RESEARCH CENTER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of paying 8 9 the expenses incurred in the operation and maintenance of the Forest and Wildlife Research Center for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000...... 11 12\$ 5,365,417.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 14 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available 15 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Forest and 16 Wildlife Research Center, for the fiscal year beginning 17 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 1,500,380.00. 18 SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 19 20 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions 2.1 of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 22 SECTION 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that if the 23 funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or 24 25 indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants, research grants or donations, such special source funds not 26

27 classified as restricted funds shall be added and accounted for

28 under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the intention of the

- 29 Legislature that all such aforementioned special source funds be
- 30 included in all reports and requests for the 2000 Regular Session
- 31 of the Mississippi Legislature.
- 32 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 33 agency's budget request for fiscal year 2001 shall be submitted to
- 34 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 35 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 36 during the fiscal year 2000 budget request process.
- 37 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 38 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement
- 39 Fund as follows:
- 40 (a) Three Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand One Hundred Fifty-
- one Dollars (\$339,151.00) shall be derived from
- funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
- 43 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 44 (b) Four Hundred Fifty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars
- 45 (\$451,900.00) shall be derived from funds deposited
- 46 pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code
- 47 of 1972.
- 48 SECTION 7. Should revenues generated and deposited to the
- 49 Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1),
- 50 Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein
- 51 from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 52 Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and
- 53 Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure
- 54 that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.
- SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 56 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 57 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 58 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 59 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 60 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 61 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after July 1, 1999.
