SENATE BILL NO. 3155
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR
3 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
8 expenses of the Department of Economic and Community Development
9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
10 June 30, 2000..... \$ 30,205,248.00.

11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Economic and Community
14 Development or the appropriate special fund for the purpose of
15 defraying the expenses incurred in the operation of the various
16 divisions of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
17 1999 and ending June 30, 2000.....
18 \$ 122,140,854.00.

19 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
20 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

26 From the funds provided in this act, funds may be expended

27 for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies
28 established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed
29 on such expenditures:

30 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
31 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
32 appropriated herein.

33 (b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
34 Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
35 full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
36 current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
37 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
38 adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
39 Dollars (\$1,000.00).

40 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
41 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
42 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any
43 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a
44 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the
45 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently
46 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above
47 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase
48 effective the date of the rating.

49 It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds
50 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal
51 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for
52 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the
53 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

54 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
55 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
56 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
57 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

58 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
59 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall

60 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray
61 the expenses of the Department of Economic and Community
62 Development in operating the state welcome centers.

63 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and
64 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or
65 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,
66 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United
67 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may
68 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the
69 Department of Economic and Community Development or any programs
70 sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby
71 authorized not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and
72 approved, provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and
73 otherwise accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et
74 seq., and Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

75 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
76 Department of Economic and Community Development is hereby
77 authorized to escalate and expend funds from any source not to
78 exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with
79 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
80 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
81 federal funds.

82 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
83 Department of Economic and Community Development shall maintain
84 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
85 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
86 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
87 maintained for Fiscal Year 1999. It is further the intention of
88 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
89 2001 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
90 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
91 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request
92 process.

93 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
94 amount of Nine Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
95 (\$9,200,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
96 provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism
97 Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2000. The expenditure
98 of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section
99 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

100 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
101 provided in Section 8 for the purpose of supporting Mississippi
102 Tourism Advertising and Promotion, an amount to be determined by
103 the Department of Economic and Community Development is authorized
104 to establish the Mississippi Motion Picture Incentive Program.
105 Monies committed to this program shall not lapse into the State
106 General Fund at the end of the fiscal year.

107 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
108 amount of Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
109 (\$2,200,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
110 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and
111 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2000.
112 The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be
113 exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

114 SECTION 11. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
115 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
116 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
117 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
118 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
119 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
120 performance measures provided below:

150 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets
151 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the
152 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
153 Committee for Fiscal Year 2001.

154 SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein
155 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
156 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
157 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
158 Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing

159 funds for the Institute for Technology Development, for the fiscal
160 year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....
161 \$ 750,000.00.

162 The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
163 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
164 support of the Institute for Technology Development to equip,
165 operate and maintain a post-graduate, integrated circuit design,
166 engineering training program, known as ComPEET. The funds herein
167 appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds
168 appropriated to the Department of Economic and Community
169 Development.

170 SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein
171 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
172 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
173 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
174 Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing
175 funds for Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, for the fiscal
176 year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....
177 \$ 1,500,000.00.

178 The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
179 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
180 support of Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, to strengthen the
181 business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and
182 growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more
183 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi
184 economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
185 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of
186 Economic and Community Development.

187 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Five
188 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) is provided for support of
189 the Royal Spanish Treasures Exhibit. It is the intention of the
190 Legislature that the Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00)
191 authorized in this section shall lapse into the State General Fund

192 at the end of fiscal year 2000 if it is not used for the Royal
193 Spanish Treasurers Exhibit.

194 SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
195 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
196 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
197 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
198 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
199 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

200 SECTION 16. This act shall take effect and be in force from
201 and after July 1, 1999.
