5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30,

L1	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L2	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
L3	funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi

From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal
Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be
expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the
policies established by the State Personnel Board and any
conditions placed on such expenditures:
(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
appropriated herein.
(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00).
(c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any

- 60 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a
- 61 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the
- 62 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently
- 63 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above
- 64 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase

- It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds
- 67 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal

- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

- 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 86 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
