Employees who subsequently 63 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 64 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 65 effective the date of the rating.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

71 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 72 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a nonprofit organization.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 81 82 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 83 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 84 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 86 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 87 and after July 1, 1999. 88

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
