1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI 2 BUREAU OF NARCOTICS OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY 3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for payment of the 7 expenses of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi 8 9 Department of Public Safety, created by Section 41-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 10 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 15,316,491.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the 14 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of 15 Public Safety which is comprised of special source funds collected 16 by or otherwise available to the agency, for the support and 17 maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 18 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 1,317,322.00. 19 20 SECTION 3. To be eligible for any 61 62 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 63 64 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 65 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 66 effective the date of the rating. 67

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance withthe terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

95 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 96 Section 2, funds are included to defray the costs of clothing for 97 sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One 98 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.

99 SECTION 6. Funds are provided in this act to reallocate one 100 (1) Public Information Officer to Public Relations Director at an 101 annualized cost not to exceed Eleven Thousand One Hundred 102 Forty-three Dollars (\$11,143.00), and one (1) BN-Intelligence 103 Analyst to BN-Intelligence Analyst Senior at an annualized cost 104 not to exceed One Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars 105 (\$1,899.00).

SECTION 7. In addition to the salary increases provided in 106 107 Section 3 (b) of this act, the compensation of each narcotics 108 agent in full-time employment with the Department of Narcotics 109 shall be increased by One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually from funds authorized in Section 2 from the Law Enforcement 110 111 Officers Training Fund. To effectuate this salary increase, the State Personnel Board, pursuant to rules promulgated by the board, 112 113 shall provide for realignment and a cost-of-living increase.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 114 115 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 116 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 117 118 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 119 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 120 121 and after July 1, 1999.
