From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

37 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all

Employees who subsequently receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 53 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 54 effective the date of the rating. 55

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the

61 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. Funds are provided in this act to reallocate PIN 68 24 from Administrative Supervising Examiner to Director, Consumer 69 Finance Division, with a start step of Fifty-two Thousand One 70 Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$52,179.00).

71 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 and allocated in Section 2, funds in the amount of One 72 Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) and two (2) 73 74 full-time positions are provided to carry out the provisions of 75 House Bill No. 1128, Regular Session of 1999. In the event that 76 House Bill No. 1128, Regular Session of 1999, is not enacted into law, it is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of 77 78 Banking and Consumer Finance shall not expend One Hundred Twentyfive Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) of the funds appropriated 79 80 under the provisions of Section 1, nor shall the Department fill more than thirty-seven (37) of the full-time positions authorized 81 82 in Section 2 of this act.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 83 84 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 85 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 86 87 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 88 89 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 90 and after July 1, 1999.

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
