4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Banking
8	and Consumer Finance, for the support of the State Department of
9	Banking and Consumer Finance, for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000
11	\$ 3,335,642.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

27 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 28 Permanent: Full Time. 39 29 Part Time. Time-Limited: Full Time. 30 31 From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal 32 Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits, " funds may be 33 expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the 34 35 policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures: 36 The components of the Variable Compensation Plan 37 38 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds 39 appropriated herein. 40 (b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all 41 42 full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous 43 current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to 44 45 adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). 46 47 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 48 49 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 50 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 51 52 effective date of the increase. - 74 full-time positions are provided to carry out the provisions of

- 76 House Bill No. 1128, Regular Session of 1999, is not enacted into
- 77 law, it is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of
- 78 Banking and Consumer Finance shall not expend One Hundred Twenty-

- 86 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 87 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 88 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 90 and after July 1, 1999.
