1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI PROFESSIONAL 3 COUNSELOR LICENSING BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Professional Counselor Licensing Board, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 8 9 board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 10 June 30, 2000.....\$ 59,975.00. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 11 12 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 17 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 18 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 19 20 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 21 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 22 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after July 1, 1999. 24
