4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Office of State Aid Road
9	Construction of the Mississippi Department of Transportation for
LO	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30,
L1	2000\$ 20,000,000.00.
L2	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L3	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
L4	Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road
L5	Construction Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
L6	the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi
L7	Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning

48	(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
49	shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds

- 82 counties and municipalities in the replacement and rehabilitation
- 83 of certain bridges located on local road systems in the counties
- 84 and in municipalities within the counties.
- 85 SECTION 5. Funds are provided in this act to reallocate one
- 86 (1) Secretary Principal to Secretary Executive at an annualized
- 87 cost not to exceed Two Thousand Thirty-nine Dollars (\$2,039.00),
- 88 and one (1) Contracts Officer to Contracts Officer Senior at an
- 89 annualized cost not to exceed Two Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-
- 90 six Dollars (\$2,736.00).
- 91 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 92 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

93 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

94 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

95 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

96 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

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98 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

99 and after July 1, 1999.
