5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State			
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Workers' Compensation			
8	Commission, for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred by			
9	said commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and			
10	ending June 30, 2000\$ 5,299,999.00

- 70 the purpose of implementing a safety education and training
- 71 program.
- 72 SECTION 4. With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 73 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- 74 transfer a sum or sums not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 75 (\$200,000.00) from the Administration Expense Fund to the Second
- 76 Injury Fund.
- 77 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 80 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 81 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 82 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 83 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 84 and after July 1, 1999.
