AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 930, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1994, 2 TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF MILES THAT THE TOWN OF STATE LINE, MISSISSIPPI, MAY EXPAND ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM OUTSIDE ITS 4 CORPORATE LIMITS. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE 5 OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 930, Local and Private Laws of 1994, is
- amended as follows: 8
- Section 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 9
- 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing 10
- 11 authorities of the Town of State Line, in Greene and Wayne
- Counties, Mississippi, in their discretion, may construct, expand, 12
- 13 operate and maintain the water distribution system of the Town of
- 14 State Line for a distance not to exceed seventeen (17) miles from
- the corporate limits of the Town of State Line. Whenever such 15
- water utility service is furnished to any consumer residing 16
- outside the corporate limits of the Town of State Line, the 17
- 18 consumer may not be charged at a rate greater than twice the rate
- charged for the same service within the corporate limits of the 19
- Town of State Line. 20
- 21 (2) The authority conferred by this act shall not be
- construed as an exemption from the provisions of Section 77-3-1 et 22
- seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as to the requirements for 23
- obtaining a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, the 24
- 25 jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission to regulate rates or
- 26 any other provisions of that law.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 27
- 28 and after its passage.
