SENATE BILL NO. 3223
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO WILLIE BLEDSOE OF
2 LINCOLN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF
3 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
6 completely restored to Willie Bledsoe of Lincoln County,
7 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
8 conviction of the crimes of grand larceny and burglary of a
9 dwelling in 1984 in Lincoln County, Mississippi, and who has
10 completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon him for such
11 conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed that he is
12 now conducting himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a
13 good and lawful manner.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
