SENATE BILL NO. 3223 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO WILLIE BLEDSOE OF 1 LINCOLN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF 2 3 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and completely restored to Willie Bledsoe of Lincoln County, 6 7 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction of the crimes of grand larceny and burglary of a 8 dwelling in 1984 in Lincoln County, Mississippi, and who has 9 10 completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon him for such 11 conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a 12 13 good and lawful manner. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 14

15 and after its passage.
