- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 972, Local and Private Laws of 1994, is
- amended as follows:
- Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Adams County may 9
- 10 require that every vessel, as defined in Section 27-109-1,
- 11 Mississippi Code of 1972, that docks in Adams County outside of
- the corporate limits of the City of Natchez, as such limits 12
- existed on December 31, 1993, and on which legal gaming is 13
- 14 conducted, pay a fee in an amount not to exceed three and
- 15 two-tenths percent (3.2%) of the gross revenue of such vessel per
- calendar month. 16
- 17 If the amount of fees required to be reported and paid
- pursuant to this section is later determined to be greater or less 18
- than the amount actually reported and paid by the vessel, the 19
- Chairman of the State Tax Commission shall: 20
- (a) Assess and collect the additional license fees 21
- 22 determined to be due, with interest thereon until paid; or
- (b) Advise the board of supervisors to refund any 23
- overpayment, with interest thereon, to the vessel. Interest must 2.4
- be computed, until paid, at the rate of one percent (1%) per month 25
- from the first day of the first month following either the due 26
- date of the additional fee or the date of overpayment. 2.7

- The State Tax Commission shall calculate, collect and enforce
- 29 the collection of such fee as provided for the calculation,
- 30 collection and enforcement of the license fee under Section
- 31 75-76-177, Mississippi Code of 1972. Not less than thirty (30)
- 32 days before the effective date of the fee, the board of
- 33 supervisors shall furnish the State Tax Commission a certified
- 34 copy of the ordinance enacting the fee and establishing the
- 35 effective date, which shall be the first day of any month.
- 36 Seventy-five percent (75%) of the avails of such fee are allocated
- 37 to Adams County, and twenty-five percent (25%) of the avails of
- 38 such fee are allocated to the City of Natchez. The State Tax
- 39 Commission shall send the avails of such fee to the county and
- 40 municipality on or before the tenth day of each month following
- 41 the month in which the fee was collected. Such monies shall be
- 42 deposited into the general fund of the county and the general fund
- 43 of the municipality. Such monies shall be expended by the county
- 44 as follows: (a) for the construction, operation and maintenance
- 45 of infrastructure relating to roads, rights-of-way,
- 46 transportation, parking facilities, access, utilities, lighting,
- 47 traffic and safety devices, and related purposes; (b) for the
- 48 promotion of tourism, including, but not limited to, advertising
- 49 and construction of meeting and conference facilities; (c) for
- 50 fire protection, security and law enforcement equipment and
- 51 personnel related to gaming; and (d) for any other use as may be
- 52 determined by the board of supervisors. The board of supervisors
- 53 may allocate up to ten percent (10%) of such monies to fund budget
- 54 requests made by the Natchez-Adams School District.
- 55 Section 2. The fee authorized in Section 1 of this act is in
- 56 addition to the license fee authorized in Section 75-76-195,
- 57 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 58 Section 3. Any vessel on which legal gaming is conducted
- 59 during the time that such vessel is docked in Adams County outside
- 60 the corporate limits of the City of Natchez is subject to zoning

- 61 regulations imposed by the board of supervisors to promote the
- 62 health and safety of the community, and the Mississippi Gaming
- 63 Commission may conduct inspections of such vessel to ensure
- 64 compliance with those regulations.
- 65 Section 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after its passage.
- 67 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 68 and after its passage.
