SENATE BILL NO. 3233

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JACKSON 2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO ESTABLISH A MITIGATION BANK UTILIZING ANY COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR THE OPERATION OF THE 4 COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE A CERTAIN PIECE OF PROPERTY TO BE UTILIZED IN 5 SUCH MITIGATION BANK UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JACKSON COUNTY TO EXPEND FUNDS TO IMPROVE 6 7 THE MARKETABILITY OF PROPERTY AS A MITIGATION BANK OR FOR SALE AS 8 WETLANDS MITIGATION LAND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9

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- SECTION 1. For the purposes of this act:
- 12 (a) "Mitigation bank" means a managed site where
- 13 wetlands and/or other aquatic resources are restored, created,
- 14 enhanced, or in exceptional circumstances, preserved expressly for
- 15 the purpose of providing compensatory mitigation due to or in
- 16 advance of authorized impacts to similar resources.
- 17 (b) "Mitigation credit" means a unit of measure
- 18 representing the accrual or attainment of aquatic functions at a
- 19 mitigation bank.
- 20 SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County,
- 21 Mississippi, is hereby authorized and empowered to set up, own,
- 22 operate and maintain a mitigation bank with any county-owned
- 23 property no longer needed for the operation of the county and to
- 24 sell mitigation credits in said bank provided that such board
- 25 finds that:
- 26 (a) The sale of such credits is for fair market value;
- 27 and
- 28 (b) The sale of such credits will promote and foster
- 29 the development and improvement of the community or the economic
- 30 or industrial welfare thereof.

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31 SECTION 3. The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County may
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- 32 make any agreements required with any federal and/or state
- 33 regulatory agencies in furtherance of the provisions of this act.
- 34 SECTION 4. The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County is
- 35 specifically authorized and empowered to utilize the following
- 36 described real property owned by Jackson County, Mississippi, as a
- 37 mitigation bank or to sell the subject property as mitigation
- 38 lands provided that the sum of Four Hundred Eighty Thousand
- 39 Dollars (\$480,000.00) is replaced or is reserved to be replaced
- 40 into the proceeds of the General Obligation Bonds (Port Road
- 41 Improvement Project), Series 1993 of Jackson County, Mississippi,
- 42 dated September 1, 1993, in the aggregate principal amount of Four
- 43 Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00). Such property is described as
- 44 follows:
- 45 Governmental Lots 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12;
- the North One-Half (N 1/2) of Governmental Lot 3; and
- 47 the South One-Half (S 1/2) of Governmental Lot 4, all
- situated in Section 8, Township 7 South, Range 4 West,
- Jackson County, Mississippi, less and except, however,
- all oil, gas and mineral rights which have been
- reserved by prior owners, and subject to a right-of-way
- 52 easement of the L&N Railroad.
- The balance of any proceeds generated from operation of a
- 54 mitigation bank or from sale of the subject property shall be paid
- 55 into the general county fund.
- 56 SECTION 5. The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County is
- 57 hereby authorized and empowered to expend from funds otherwise
- 58 available to such board such sums as are reasonable and necessary
- 59 to improve the marketability of property as a mitigation bank or
- 60 for sale as wetlands mitigation land and to employ any
- 61 professionals and expend any sums for any purpose reasonable and
- 62 necessary to carry out the provisions of this act.
- 63 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
