SENATE BILL NO. 3241
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF
2 TAYLORSVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT, IN ADDITION TO
3 ANY OTHER ASSESSMENTS AND COURT COSTS, FOR EACH MISDEMEANOR CASE
4 PROCESSED THROUGH THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF SUCH TOWN; TO PROVIDE
5 THAT THE AVAILS OF SUCH ADDITIONAL ASSESSMENT SHALL BE PAID TO
6 SMITH COUNTY CRIMESTOPPERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. (1) The governing authorities of the Town of
9 Taylorsville, Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized, by
10 resolution duly adopted and entered on the minutes of the
11 governing authorities, to levy an assessment, in addition to any
12 other assessments and court costs, not to exceed One Dollar
13 (\$1.00) per case, for each misdemeanor case processed through the
14 municipal court of the Town of Taylorsville.

15 (2) The avails of the additional assessment imposed pursuant
16 to subsection (1) of this section shall be paid by the Town of
17 Taylorsville to Smith County Crimestoppers for use in procuring
18 information to aid authorities in the capture and conviction of
19 persons committing crimes in Smith County, Mississippi.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after its passage.
