SENATE BILL NO. 3256 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF 2 WEIR, MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER 3 ASSESSMENTS AND COURT COSTS, FOR EACH MISDEMEANOR CASE FILED IN 4 ITS MUNICIPAL COURT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE AVAILS OF SUCH ADDITIONAL 5 ASSESSMENT SHALL BE USED TO FUND THE CRIMESTOPPERS PROGRAM; AND 6 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. (1) The governing authorities of the Town of 8 Weir, Mississippi, in their discretion, are authorized, by 9 resolution duly adopted and entered on the minutes of the 10 11 governing authorities, to levy an assessment, in addition to any other assessments and court costs, not to exceed Two Dollars 12 (\$2.00) per case, for each misdemeanor case filed in the municipal 13 14 court of the Town of Weir.

15 (2) The avails of the additional assessment imposed pursuant 16 to subsection (1) of this section shall be expended by the Town of 17 Weir to fund the crimestoppers program for use in crime 18 prevention, drug education, and in procuring information to aid 19 authorities in the capture and conviction of persons committing 20 crimes in Choctaw County.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after its passage.
