- 10 as follows:
- Section 73. The Governor may veto parts of any 11
- 12 appropriation, general or revenue bill and approve parts of the
- same, and the parts approved shall be law. He may veto a 13
- 14 condition of an appropriation bill.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be 15
- submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on 16
- 17 the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November 1999, as
- provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law. 18
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of the amendment 19
- 20 for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- constitutional amendment allows the Governor to veto parts of any 21
- appropriation, general or revenue bill, and to veto a condition of 22
- an appropriation bill." 23
