- 9 as follows:
- Section 70. No revenue bill, or any bill providing for 10
- assessments of property for taxation, shall become a law except by 11
- 12 a vote of at least three-fifths (3/5) of the members of each house
- 13 present and voting. Passage of any bill providing for the
- reduction of taxes shall require a majority vote of the members of 14
- 15 each house present and voting for passage.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be 16
- 17 submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on
- the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 1999 in the 18
- manner provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law. 19
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of the amendment
- for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed amendment 2.1
- 22 provides that bills reducing taxes will require a majority vote
