## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 523 (As Adopted by Senate)

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890 TO ADD A NEW SECTION, TO BE
DESIGNATED AS SECTION 272-B, TO PROVIDE THAT ALL ASSETS, PROCEEDS
AND INCOME OF THE SPECIAL TRUST FUND KNOWN AS THE "MISSISSIPPI
FIRE FIGHTERS MEMORIAL BURN CENTER FUND" SHALL BE HELD, INVESTED
AND DISBURSED FOR THE EXCLUSIVE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE
SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE BURN CENTER AND SHALL NOT BE
DIVERTED TO OTHER PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 10 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 11 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 12 state:
- 13 Amend by adding the following section:
- 14 <u>Section 272-B.</u> All assets, proceeds and income of the
- 15 special trust fund known as the "Mississippi Fire Fighters
- 16 Memorial Burn Center Fund" shall be held and invested as
- 17 authorized by law and shall be disbursed in trust for the
- 18 exclusive purpose of providing for the support and maintenance of
- 19 the burn center. The trust fund shall not be encumbered for or
- 20 diverted to other purposes.
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be
- 22 submitted to the qualified electors at an election held on the
- 23 first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 1999, as provided
- 24 by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law.
- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this
- 26 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 27 amendment protects the special trust fund known as the
- 28 'Mississippi Fire Fighters Memorial Burn Center Fund' by providing
- 29 that the fund can only be used for the exclusive purpose of

30 funding the burn center."
