A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO CREATE A STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE TAX SYSTEM OF THIS STATE AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON 1 2 3 TO THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE 5 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That: б (1) There is hereby created a study committee on the tax 7 system of Mississippi. The committee shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature during the 2000 8 9 Regular Legislative Session, including any recommended legislation. 10 (2) The committee shall be composed of the following 11 12 members: 13 (a) The President Pro Tempore of the Mississippi Senate. 14 The Speaker Pro Tempore of the Mississippi House of 15 (b) Representatives. 16 (c) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations 17 Committee. 18 The Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee. 19 (d) 20 (e) The Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee. 21 The Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee. (f) The State Treasurer, or his designee. 22 (g) The Executive Director of the Department of Finance 23 (h) and Administration. 24 25 The State Auditor, or his designee. (i) 26 (j) One (1) member designated by the State Tax

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28 (k) One (1) member designated by the State Board of29 Public Accountancy.

30 (1) One (1) member designated by the President of The
31 Mississippi Bar from the Taxation Section of The Mississippi Bar.
32 (m) One (1) member designated by the Mississippi
33 Supervisors Association.

34 (n) One (1) member designated by the Mississippi35 Municipal Association.

36 (o) Three (3) representatives of the general public,
37 one (1) designated by the Governor, one (1) by the Lieutenant
38 Governor and one (1) by the Speaker of the House of
39 Representatives.

Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after the 40 adoption of this resolution by the Legislature, and, within 41 42 fifteen (15) days thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by 43 the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the House, the committee shall meet and organize by selecting from its membership 44 a chairman and a vice-chairman. The vice-chairman shall also 45 serve as secretary and shall be responsible for keeping all 46 47 records of the committee. A majority of the members of the committee shall constitute a quorum. In the selection of its 48 officers and the adoption of rules, resolutions and reports, an 49 50 affirmative vote of a majority of the committee shall be required. All members shall be notified in writing of all meetings, such 51 52 notices to be mailed at least five (5) days prior to the date on 53 which a meeting is to be held.

54 (3) The committee shall study and make recommendations with 55 respect to the imposition of state taxes and the granting of tax 56 exemptions in all areas of taxation, including, but not limited 57 to, sales taxes, income taxes, privilege taxes, fuel taxes, 58 diversions of taxes and the relationship between state and local 59 taxes.

No. 527 99\SS02\R970 PAGE 2 60 (4) Members of the committee who are not legislators, state 61 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem rate authorized by Section 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 62 shall be reimbursed in accordance with Section 25-3-41, 63 64 Mississippi Code of 1972, for mileage and actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Legislative members of the 65 committee shall be paid from the contingent expense funds of their 66 respective houses in the same manner as provided for committee 67 68 meetings when the Legislature is not in session; however, no per 69 diem or expense for attending meetings of the committee will be paid while the Legislature is in session. No committee member may 70 71 incur per diem, travel or other expenses unless previously 72 authorized by vote, at a meeting of the committee, which action 73 shall be recorded in the official minutes of the meeting. 74 Non-legislative members shall be paid from any funds made 75 available to the committee for that purpose.

76 The committee shall utilize clerical and legal staff (5)77 already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance 78 made available to it. To effectuate the purpose of this resolution, any department, division, board, bureau, commission or 79 agency of the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, 80 at the request of the chairman of the committee, provide to the 81 committee such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the 82 committee properly to carry out its task. 83

84 (6) Upon presentation of its report to the 2000 Regular85 Legislative Session, the committee shall be dissolved.

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
