SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 529

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING A NEW SECTION TO THE
- 2 MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890 TO PROVIDE THAT THE RIGHT OF DUE
- 3 PROCESS, WHEREBY NO PERSON MAY BE DEPRIVED OF LIFE, LIBERTY OR
- 4 PROPERTY WITHOUT DUE PROCESS OF LAW, WHICH IS GUARANTEED BY
- 5 ARTICLE 3, SECTION 14 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890,
- 6 VESTS AT FERTILIZATION.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 8 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 9 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 10 state:
- 11 Amend by adding the following section:
- 12 Section ____. The right of due process, whereby no person may
- 13 be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of
- 14 law, which is guaranteed by Article 3, Section 14 of this
- 15 constitution, vests at fertilization.
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the qualified electors at an election held on the
- 18 first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 1999, as provided
- 19 by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this
- 21 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 22 constitutional amendment provides that the right of due process,
- 23 whereby no person may be deprived of life, liberty or property
- 24 without due process of law, which is guaranteed by Article 3,
- 25 Section 14 of the Mississippi Constitution, vests at
- 26 fertilization."
