SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 549
(As Adopted by Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING
2 BLACKBURN MIDDLE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL WILL REVIES UPON BEING NAMED
3 ADMINISTRATOR OF THE YEAR FOR THE JACKSON PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 WHEREAS, Blackburn Middle School Principal Will Revies has
6 been named Administrator of the Year for the Jackson Public School
7 district; and

8 WHEREAS, his nomination will be forwarded to the State
9 Department of Education, which will announce an overall
10 Mississippi winner by the end of the year; and

11 WHEREAS, Revies, who is from Hattiesburg, has been a resident
12 of Jackson for thirty years and Principal at Blackburn Middle
13 School for eight years. He has an undergraduate degree from
14 Jackson State University in health and physical education; and

15 WHEREAS, Revies has a master's degree in education
16 administration from Jackson State University, has worked for
17 Jackson Public Schools for thirteen years, and is a former
18 assistant principal at Forest Hill High School and former
19 vice-principal at Pearl High School; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Revies is energetic and interested in his
21 students, willing to go beyond the workday to provide services to
22 students in his community and has been instrumental in bringing
23 innovative educational programs into his school; and

24 WHEREAS, at Blackburn Middle School he has begun several
25 programs to enhance learning, such as Saturday morning classes and
26 summer programs. The programs help students improve math skills,

27 learn social skills and improve science and technology skills; and

28 WHEREAS, a committee comprised of five assistant
29 superintendents familiar with administrators at the district's
30 fifty-eight schools selected Revies, basing their selection on
31 looking at records and achievements of the administrators; and

32 WHEREAS, Revies is married to Goldia Revies, Public Affairs
33 Director for WLBT-TV3, and they are the parents of three
34 daughters, Michelle, Lisa and Kesha; and

35 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
36 dedicated school administrator who represents excellence in
37 education in the public school system of our state:

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
39 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we
40 do hereby commend and congratulate Blackburn Middle School
41 Principal Will Revies upon being named Administrator of the Year
42 for the Jackson Public School District.
