- 5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dale Kelly Love was elected to serve as
- 6 President General of the National Society Daughters of the
- 7 American Revolution for 1998-2001; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dale Kelly Love is a native Mississippian who
- 9 is leading the largest patriotic organization of women in the
- 10 world with over 178,000 members in over 3,000 chapters in every
- 11 state of the Union and six countries; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dale Kelly Love is a talented and devoted
- 13 member of the DAR who has served the national society on every
- 14 level; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dale Kelly Love joined the National Society
- 16 Daughters of the American Revolution in 1955 and has over 43 years
- 17 of continuous membership in four chapters; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Dale Kelly Love has served the Mississippi
- 19 State Society as State Regent, State Historian and as Chairman of
- 20 the DAR Good Citizens, Membership, National Defense,
- 21 Transportation and Finance Committees; and
- 22 WHEREAS, her extensive research efforts revealed the unique
- 23 historical significance of the Old French Fort Rosalie and Tobacco
- 24 Warehouse and helped lead to the designation of Rosalie as a
- 25 Registered National Historic Landmark; and
- 26 WHEREAS, under her visionary leadership the National Society
- 27 Daughters of the American Revolution is a leader in renewing the

- 29 WHEREAS, as President General, Mrs. Love has heightened

- 34 and taught instrumental and vocal music in the public schools and

- 38 on Education and the State Bicentennial of the U.S. Constitution

- 40 WHEREAS, Mrs. Love's late husband, Dale Kelly Love, was
- 41 Director of the Marching Band at the University of Southern
- 42 Mississippi; and
- WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature to commend the
