- 20 WHEREAS, he is described by Jay Orr, music critic for the
- Tennessean, as the "archivist and young soul of Nashville country 21
- 22 music tradition."; and
- WHEREAS, Serving his second term as the President of the 23
- Country Music Foundation, he maintains his own collection of old 24
- 25 guitars, photographs, vintage clothing and other country music
- 26 memorabilia, which he shares with the foundation for exhibits; and
- 27 WHEREAS, as a songwriter, his works include, "Same Old

- 28 Train, " featuring performances by Clint Black and Randy Travis and
- 29 "Milk and Honey Bound" by Pam Tillis; and
