9	Delta roots where he has chosen to stay and use his enormous
10	talent to teach children the art of the Blues; and
11	WHEREAS, "Mr. Johnnie," as his students, fans and friends
12	know him, started giving lessons to neighborhood children in the
13	evenings after he closed his automobile repair shop each day. His
14	belief that everyone has some kind of artistic talent offered a
15	welcoming environment for children to enter and explore the world
16	of the Blues; and
17	WHEREAS, his instruction grew and expanded into the public
18	schools in Mississippi and Arkansas where his students have
19	mastered their art and performed in venues from the mid-South to
20	New York City, and most recently in the Notodden Blues Festival in
21	Norway; and

WHEREAS, he helped form the Delta Blues Education Fund, a

nonprofit organization dedicated to providing instruction in the
