Quinn Mississippi 19 20 Regional Art Collection at Jackson's Municipal Art Gallery, a collection that showcases the works of Mississippi artists; and 21 22 WHEREAS, he was honored as the Southeastern Secondary Art Educator of the Year by the National Art Education Association and 23 received the Spirit of Mississippi Award from WLBT Television in 24 25 Jackson; and 26 WHEREAS, his most recent work was to illustrate two
