3	WHEREAS, on April 3, 1998, two young girls fell into the
4	frigid and flood swollen waters of Lake Ferguson; and
5	WHEREAS, upon being advised of the situation, Officer Michael
6	Gwathney of the Greenville Police Department ran to the water's
7	edge and, upon discovering that one victim had slipped beneath the
8	surface, courageously entered the icy and murky waters of Lake

- 9 Ferguson to search for the victim; and
- 10 WHEREAS, disregarding the peril to himself, Officer Michael
- 11 Gwathney swam through the cable snarled waters to aid Officer
- 12 Russell Frazier in pulling the victim to shore; and
- WHEREAS, in a dramatic scene in this stark struggle for life,
- 14 a white hand grasped a black hand and the victim was pulled to
- 15 safety; and
- 16 WHEREAS, through the prism of joyful tears, there was no
- 17 color of skin but a rainbow of compassion, courage and heroism;

- 19 WHEREAS, Officer Michael Gwathney was recommended to receive
- 20 the Medal of Merit from his department for his distinguished
- 21 actions while on duty; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the Legislature of Mississippi wishes to recognize
- 23 and thank Officer Michael Gwathney for his daring, courageous,
- 24 compassionate and heroic actions at the scene of a near tragedy:
