- 9 WHEREAS, disregarding the peril to himself, Engineer Tommy
- Brasier, without a hose line, entered the burning structure 10
- through a bedroom window; and 11
- 12 WHEREAS, in the heat and smoke, Engineer Tommy Brasier found
- 13 the two-year old child; and
- WHEREAS, in a dramatic scene in the stark struggle for life, 14
- 15 a white hand grasped a black hand and the victim was pulled to
- 16 safety; and
- WHEREAS, through the prism of joyful tears, there was no 17
- color of skin but a rainbow of compassion, courage and heroism; 18

- 20 WHEREAS, Engineer Tommy Brasier was recommended to receive
- the highest honor a fire department can bestow on a fire fighter, 21
- 22 the Golden Flame Award, for his heroic, courageous and unselfish

- and thank Engineer Tommy Brasier for his courageous and heroic 25
