## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 573 (As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING GREENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT 2 ENGINEER TOMMY BRASIER FOR HIS COURAGEOUS AND HEROIC RESCUE OF A 3 CHILD ON AUGUST 24, 1998. 4 WHEREAS, on Monday, August 24, 1998, fireman Engineer Tommy Brasier of the Greenville Fire Department responded to a 5 residential fire; and 6 7 WHEREAS, upon arrival, Engineer Tommy Brasier was told that a 8 child was inside the burning structure; and 9 WHEREAS, disregarding the peril to himself, Engineer Tommy Brasier, without a hose line, entered the burning structure 10 through a bedroom window; and 11 12 WHEREAS, in the heat and smoke, Engineer Tommy Brasier found 13 the two-year old child; and WHEREAS, in a dramatic scene in the stark struggle for life, 14 15 a white hand grasped a black hand and the victim was pulled to 16 safety; and WHEREAS, through the prism of joyful tears, there was no 17 color of skin but a rainbow of compassion, courage and heroism; 18 19 and 20 WHEREAS, Engineer Tommy Brasier was recommended to receive the highest honor a fire department can bestow on a fire fighter, 21 22 the Golden Flame Award, for his heroic, courageous and unselfish act; and 23 WHEREAS, the Legislature of Mississippi wishes to recognize 24 and thank Engineer Tommy Brasier for his courageous and heroic 25 rescue of a small child from certain death: 26
