1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING OFFICER RUSSELL FRAZIE

- 2 FOR HIS COURAGEOUS AND HEROIC EFFORTS ON APRIL 3, 1998.
- 3 WHEREAS, on April 3, 1998, two young girls fell into the
- 4 frigid and flood swollen waters of Lake Ferguson; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Upon being advised of the situation, Officer Russell
- 6 Frazier of the Greenville Police Department ran to the waters edge
- 7 and upon discovering that one victim had slipped beneath the
- 8 surface, courageously entered the icy and murky waters of Lake
- 9 Ferguson to search for the victim; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Officer Russell Frazier located the victim and
- 11 disregarding the peril to himself, he plunged beneath the surface
- 12 of the cable snarled waters to pull the victim to the surface; and
- 13 WHEREAS, with the assistance of two fellow officers, Officer
- 14 Russell Frazier brought the victim to shore; and
- WHEREAS, in a dramatic scene in this stark struggle for life,
- 16 a white hand grasped a black hand and the victim was pulled to
- 17 safety; and
- 18 WHEREAS, through the prism of joyful tears, there was no
- 19 color of skin but a rainbow of compassion, courage, and heroism;
- 20 and
- 21 WHEREAS, Officer Russell Frazier was recommended to receive
- 22 the Medal of Honor from his department for his distinguished
- 23 actions while on duty; and
- 24 WHEREAS, the Legislature of Mississippi wishes to recognize
- 25 and thank Officer Russell Frazier for his daring, courageous,
- 26 compassionate and heroic actions at the scene of a near tragedy:

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 28 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 29 we do hereby commend Officer Russell Frazier for his courageous
- 30 and heroic rescue on April 3, 1998.
