SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 591  
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MISTY  
2 GOFF OF GULFPORT, MISSISSIPPI, UPON RECEIVING THE PRUDENTIAL  
3 SPIRIT OF COMMUNITY AWARD.

4 WHEREAS, Misty Goff of Gulfport, Mississippi, has been named  
5 as one of Mississippi's top youth volunteers for 1999 in The  
6 Prudential Spirit of Community Awards, a nationwide program  
7 honoring young people for outstanding acts of volunteerism; and

8 WHEREAS, the awards program, now in its fourth year, is  
9 sponsored by The Prudential Insurance Company of America in  
10 partnership with The National Association of Secondary School  
11 Principals and honors young volunteers across America who have  
12 demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to serving their  
13 communities; and

14 WHEREAS, nearly 20,000 high school and middle school students  
15 were considered for awards in this year's program; and

16 WHEREAS, Misty Goff earned this award by volunteering for the  
17 past four years at Lynn Meadows Discovery Center, a children's  
18 museum, for which she coordinates fund raising activities and

21 strength of our communities and the overall vitality of society  
22 depends upon the dedicated efforts of young people like Miss Goff  
23 who use their talents and time to serve others:

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE  
25 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we  
26 do hereby commend and congratulate Misty Goff of Gulfport,

27 Mississippi, upon receiving The Prudential Spirit of Community  
28 Award, in recognition of her outstanding record of volunteer  
29 service, peer leadership and community spirit, and extend the best  
30 wishes for her continued success.
