1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO COMMEND THE LEE MIDDLE SCHOOL 2 ODYSSEY OF THE MIND PARTICIPANTS. 3 WHEREAS, to be successful in today's world, young people need 4 to develop problem-solving techniques; and 5 WHEREAS, one place students can learn this valuable skill, as well as creativity and teamwork, is by participating in the 6 7 Odyssey of the Mind program; and WHEREAS, this program focuses on the development of self 8 9 confidence, resourcefulness, leadership and risk taking, being the largest worldwide creative problem-solving competition for 10 11 children; and 12 WHEREAS, Odyssey of the Mind is an international program that challenges students to think both logically and creatively as they 13 14 work together in teams consisting of five to seven members; and WHEREAS, the teams are allowed to choose between five 15 16 different "problems," which are newly created each year, in which 17 to compete; and WHEREAS, nine teams from Lee Middle School competed in the 18 19 Regional Competition at Morton, Mississippi, on March 21, 1998, out of which five teams qualified to participate in the State 20 21 Finals in Ridgeland, Mississippi, held on April 4, 1998; and WHEREAS, an incredible three Lee Middle School teams took top 22 23 honors, going on to Walt Disney World in May to compete against 24 the 6,000 brightest and most creative young minds from 48 states, 25 the District of Columbia and 30 foreign countries at the World Finals; and 26

32 WHEREAS, the culminating activity of the three-day 33 competition was the closing ceremony, where the top six teams were 34 recognized; and

35 WHEREAS, the "Marvelous Mentor" team, consisting of Kim 36 Caraig, Kerry Ellis, Lindsey Kempton, Richard Lancaster, Eileen 37 Tagdulang and Kristy Watkins, took first place by a margin of 38 38 points; and

39 WHEREAS, the other two teams that competed had solid 40 finishes: "Pageant Wagon," consisting of Brent Burge, Sarah 41 Conroy, Elizabeth Davidson, Justin Davis, Gaby McCallister, Bess 42 Pearson and Lauren Vanderpool, came in 13th, and "Create and 43 Animate," consisting of J.B. Brewcyznski, Jack Catton, Adele 44 Champlin, Zach Foster, Stephanie LaBella, Jared Stork and Eric 45 Tipton, finished 17th; and
