## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 622

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE 1998-1999  
2 VICKSBURG HIGH SCHOOL "MISSY GATORS" GIRLS SOCCER TEAM FOR THEIR  
3 OUTSTANDING SEASON AND FOR WINNING THEIR SECOND STRAIGHT STATE  
4 TITLE.

5 WHEREAS, the 1998-1999 Vicksburg High School "Missy Gators"  
6 Girls Soccer Team has again reached the penthouse of Mississippi  
7 prep soccer by beating Oak Grove 3-2 to win their second straight  
8 Girls State Soccer Championship; and

9 WHEREAS, the "Missy Gators" Soccer Team has a 15-1 playoff  
10 record and has played in all four title games after winning the  
11 inaugural state championship, and there is already talk of winning  
12 a fourth title next year; and

13 WHEREAS, Vicksburg had an exceptional season, finishing the  
14 year at 19-2 after early losses, and was ranked No. 1 in the poll;

16 WHEREAS, the team was greatly assisted by "Parade"  
17 All-American Kristin Chapman, whose combination of talent, speed  
18 and savvy along with her 31 goals will be missed next year when  
19 Kristin will play for defending national champion Florida; and

20 WHEREAS, the "Missy Gators" were well and ably coached by  
21 Head Coach Kevin Manton, who, along with Athletic Director John  
22 White and School Principal Kermit Harness, were an essential part  
23 of the team's success; and

24 WHEREAS, Principal Kermit Harness was named Vicksburg-Warren  
25 Schools 1998-1999 Administrator of the Year, and under his  
26 leadership the school was awarded the United States Department of  
27 Education "Top School," and the former teacher's awards include:

28 "Star Teacher," Outstanding Band Master, Educator of the Year,  
29 United Way Community Service Award, Outstanding Service Award and  
30 Outstanding Contribution to International Education and  
31 Understanding; and
