## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 638 (As Adopted by Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND RECOGNIZING THE 2 DIABETES FOUNDATION OF MISSISSIPPI FOR ITS SERVICE EFFORTS TO 3 DIABETIC PERSONS THROUGHOUT THE STATE. 4 WHEREAS, more than 240,000 Mississippians have diabetes, an incurable disease that impairs the body's ability to convert 5 dietary sugar into energy; and 6 7 WHEREAS, 80,000 Mississippians don't know they have diabetes and another 800,000 are at high risk for developing the disease 8 9 due to lifestyle, obesity and family history; and WHEREAS, diabetes cost the state \$1.5 Billion in direct and 10 indirect cost; and 11 12 WHEREAS, although diabetes is an incurable disease, the 13 symptoms of the disease can be controlled by various means, such as diet, exercise and medications, especially if discovered in 14 15 early stages; and WHEREAS, in an effort to identify the undiagnosed before 16 17 developing one or more of the serious complications caused by diabetes including blindness, heart and kidney disease, strokes 18 and amputations, the Diabetes Foundation of Mississippi will 19 20 increase community awareness through free screenings, health fairs and public awareness screenings at corporate locations and a 21 screening at the Mississippi State Capitol on March 25, 1999: 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE 23 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we 24 do hereby commend and thank the Diabetes Foundation of Mississippi 25

for its efforts in fighting diabetes by increasing public
