SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 640

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE MIZE 2 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE MIZE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THEIR 3 QUICK RESPONSE TO THE MASSIVE FIRE IN DOWNTOWN TAYLORSVILLE ON 4 SUNDAY, JANUARY 31, 1999.

5 WHEREAS, a quick response by the Mize Volunteer Fire 6 Department and the Mize Police Department and by other area 7 volunteer fire departments on Sunday, January 31, 1999, prevented 8 a building fire from destroying downtown Taylorsville,

9 Mississippi; and

10 WHEREAS, more than 20 units from Smith and surrounding counties responded to a call for help as the old Melroy Theater, a 11 12 familiar Taylorsville landmark which housed the May Appliance Center, became engulfed in flames that destroyed the building; and 13 WHEREAS, with assistance from volunteer fire departments from 14 15 Taylorsville, Raleigh, Sylvarena, Richton, Shady Grove, Hebron, Pleasant Ridge, Powers, Soso, Myrick, Moselle, Mill Creek, Boggy 16 17 Creek, Northeast Jones, Sharon, Glade, Johnson, Mendenhall, Magee, Collins, Hot Coffee, East Covington, Stringer and Bay Springs, the 18 Mize Volunteer Fire Department battled the blaze until about 2:00 19 20 a.m. Monday, February 1, 1999; and

21 WHEREAS, according to official reports, flames had broken 22 through the roof of the building and blazed to a height of over 20 23 feet, threatening to quickly spread to other structures due to the 24 radiation of so much heat; and

25 WHEREAS, firemen saturated the walls with water from a bucket 26 truck that Entergy had provided to prevent the fire from spreading 27 until help arrived, and it would have been worse if not for the

29 WHEREAS, personnel from the Taylorsville Police Department, 30 Smith County Sheriff's Department, Soso Police Department, Jones County Sheriff's Department and Jasper County Sheriff's 31 32 Department, along with the Pine Belt Chapter of the American Red 33 Cross and the AMR Ambulance Service also responded to provide assistance, and all are to be praised for their work; and 34 35 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the hard work and quick response of all these Mississippians who helped 36

37 their neighbor when they were most needed, by preventing a 38 building fire from destroying a Mississippi town:

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE 40 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we 41 do hereby recognize and commend the Mize Volunteer Fire Department 42 and the Mize Police Department for their quick response to the 43 massive fire in downtown Taylorsville on Sunday, January 31, 1999, 44 and express our appreciation to all other units that assisted in 45 this effort.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be presented to the Chief of the Mize Volunteer Fire Department, the Mize Chief of Police and the Mayor of Mize on behalf of all personnel responding to the fire, and that copies be made available to the Capitol Press Corps.
