- 7 victories and claimed its second consecutive Class 5A State
- 8 Championship with a come-from-behind 60-57 win over Tupelo High
- 9 School; and
- 10 WHEREAS, led by the "Dandy Dozen" trio of Kesha Tardy, Ebony
- 11 Felder and Tamika Rogers, the Lady Mustangs finished the season
- 12 35-3, atop The Clarion-Ledger poll, and ranked 19th nationally by
- 13 <u>USA Today</u>, and joined Harrison Central and Warren Central as the
- 14 only teams to win back-to-back 5A crowns; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to the Class 5A State Tournament, the
- 16 Lady Mustangs won the Murrah High School Round Robin Tournament,
- 17 the Jackson Public Schools City Tournament, the Division 5-5A
- 18 Tournament and the 5A South Regional Tournament, were runner-up in
- 19 the Jackson Public School Pepsi Holiday Classic and had a 2-2
- 20 showing in California's prestigious Santa Barbara Tournament of
- 21 Champions; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Murrah is ably coached by Anna Jackson, who claimed
- 23 her third 5A title this decade and has an overall record of
- 24 399-127, and with assistant coaches Charles Dillon and Marvin
- 25 Jackson, fine tuned the athletic skills of the players and molded
- 26 them into a team; and

- 28 individual honors for excellent performance: Kesha Tardy
- 29 (averaged a team-high 17.6 points and 9 rebounds per game, was

- 32 All-Metro and All-State Player), Tamika Rogers (averaged 13.9
- 33 points per game, was selected All-Metro and All-State Player), and
- 34 other team players include Raven Rogers, LaShundra Speech, Alicia
- 35 Jenkins, Courtney Cockrell, Crystal Jackson, Felicia Farrar,
- 36 Sharon Hurley, Olicia King, Tomekia Reed, Christina Buford,
- 37 LaTonya Johnson, Shaneka Jones, Managers Ayana Hudson, Quentessa
- 38 Jackson and April Carter and Statistician Richard Howard; and
