## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 655 (As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE SUCCESSFUL CAREER OF 2 PEARL RIVER COUNTY CIRCUIT CLERK PEGGY STATEN UPON THE OCCASION OF 3 HER RETIREMENT FROM OFFICE.

4 WHEREAS, Peggy Staten, Pearl River County's Circuit Clerk since 1980, has decided not to run for another term in office; and 5 б WHEREAS, Peggy stated that she never imagined a career in 7 politics, but after serving 20 years as an elected official, she says that she cannot imagine having had any other career; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Staten began her work in the Pearl River County Circuit Court in 1975 when she was hired as a deputy circuit clerk 10 under the leadership of long-time clerk Monroe Spiers, and she 11 12 credits much of her success in the past and today to Spiers' 13 guidance and leadership; and

14 WHEREAS, when Spiers decided not to run for reelection in 15 1979, she hastily decided to run for the position, and as one of 16 six candidates for the office, she was the only one who had direct 17 experience and was elected; and

18 WHEREAS, since Staten took office in 1980, many changes have 19 taken place in the administration of the clerk's office, including 20 the use of technology to modernize the duties of the clerk and her 21 staff, the computerization of office records and machine-counting 22 of election results; and

23 WHEREAS, the workload of her office has increased as the 24 county's population has steadily increased, and the clerk's office 25 employs five full-time clerks who handle voter registration, 26 wedding licenses, keep records from civil circuit cases and

31 WHEREAS, Peggy Staten's attention to detail and concern for 32 the public is evidenced by the smooth operation of her office over 33 the years and the dedication and positive attitudes of the deputy 34 clerks; and

35 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the dedicated public service of this public official, who has brought 36 honor to her office, her county and to the State of Mississippi: 37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 38 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That 39 we do hereby commend the successful career of Pearl River Circuit 40 Clerk Peggy Staten upon the occasion of her retirement from 41 office, and wish her and her family much success in her future 42 endeavors. 43
