## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 658 (As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING GARY 2 GRUBBS OF PRENTISS, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS PROLIFIC ACTING AND SCRIPTWRITING CAREER, UPON THE OCCASION OF THE NEW STAGE THEATRE 3 PRODUCTION OF HIS PLAY "AS THE CROW FLIES". 4 5 WHEREAS, Gary Grubbs resigned from his job as a bulldozer salesman in Prentiss, Mississippi, and in 1977 he and his wife, 6 7 Glenda, moved to Los Angeles from Mississippi to pursue careers in the entertainment industry; and 8 WHEREAS, now some twenty years later Gary has worked for some 9 10 of the most distinguished directors of our time, in a number of motion pictures including "JFK" (Oliver Stone), "Silkwood" (Mike 11 Nichols), and "Honkytonk Man" (Clint Eastwood), and this summer he 12 was featured in "X-Files The Movie" and can be seen in 13 "Astronaut's Wife" to be released next year; and 14 15 WHEREAS, on television, Grubbs initially made a name for himself by portraying attorneys in two of the highest rated 16 17 programs in television history, "The Burning Bed" and "Fatal Vision," and has appeared on "The X-Files," "Touched by an Angel," 18 "JAG" and "ER," and currently Gary can be seen on the new "Will 19 20 and Grace" series for NBC; and WHEREAS, "As the Crow Flies" is his first full-length play 21 22 and he is thrilled that The New Stage Theatre in Jackson, Mississippi, is mounting this first production, and as a 23 24 screenwriter he has successfully sold scripts to CBS and the USA 25 networks; and WHEREAS, Gary's family has quite a history of public service 26 in Mississippi: Gary's father was Sheriff of Jefferson Davis 27
